NOTES ON COMPLETION OF FORM C6

These notes should be read in conjunction with the relevant legislation.

- General** This form must be completed correctly, in full and in accordance with the following notes. Where “not applicable”, “nil” or “none” is appropriate, please state. Where the space provided on Form C6 is considered inadequate, the information should be presented on a continuation sheet in the same format as the relevant section in the form. The use of a continuation sheet must be so indicated in the relevant section.
- note one** The proposed company name must be given in full and must correspond **exactly** with the CRO record.
- note two** This is the number allocated to the charge on the Register of Charges held by the Registrar of Companies. Under section 103 Companies Act 1963 details from the Register of Charges, including this number, are included in the information given on a company printout which is available from the CRO on payment of the appropriate fee.
- note three** The chargee is the person entitled to the charge, usually the party providing the finance.
- note four** Enter either the date of the deed creating the charge or the date of registration of the charge. Delete as appropriate. Both dates appear on a company printout.
- note five** The signatories are required to be the company secretary and one of the company directors. Please note that an officer cannot act as both director and secretary in completing the form. Where a person signs in one capacity, he or she may not sign the form in another capacity.
- note six** This section must be completed by the person who is presenting the application form to the Registrar of Companies. This may be either the applicant or a person on his/her behalf.

A Form C6 that is not completed correctly or is not accompanied by the correct fee is liable to be rejected and returned to the presenter by the CRO pursuant to section 249A Companies Act 1990 (inserted by section 107 Company Law Enforcement Act 2001). Unless the document, duly corrected, is re-lodged in the CRO within 14 days, it will be deemed to have never been delivered to the CRO.
